Landscape Designer	\$825	All Landscape Designer Members <u>MUST:</u> • be involved in Residential and/or Commercial Landscape Design • be covered by appropriate insurances; and • not be involved in contracting the installation of landscapes.
Maintenance		
Garden Maintenance Contractor	\$7 4 3	All Garden Maintenance Contractor Members MUST: • be involved in Residential Landscape Maintenance services • be covered by appropriate insurances; and • not be involved in contracting the installation of landscapes.
Industry Supplier		
Industry Supplier	\$1,155	All Industry Supplier Members MUST: • be involved in supplying goods and services to the Landscape, Design and Construction Industry; or • be a provider of educational and/or training in the Landscape Design and Construction Industry.
Development		
Student Membership	\$65	A Student Member may run their own business but must only be working part time, with ≥50% of their time dedicated to their studies. All Student Members must be currently enrolled in an approved Landscape Design or Construction Qualification (proof of enrolment must be provided upon request). No application fee is payable by Student Members. NOTE: Student Members are entitled to all MLSA member benefits except for the right to vote at MLSA meetings and the right to enter the MLSA Awards of Excellence. Both privileges are reserved for full MLSA members.
